### Open Shelter Information

**Welcome to the Creekside Park Open Shelter. Our staff will make every effort to assist with your event and ensure a great experience for you and your guests. If you have questions or concerns prior to your event contact the Park Manager by phone or email.**

The Open Shelter is located at the south end of the park in a sunny area. The Open Shelter is approximately 30' x 50' in dimension and comes with 18 eight-foot picnic tables. This shelter has a capacity of 150 guests. There is electric service to the open shelter. There are a water spigot and a double, charcoal grill available for your use. There is a short, paved path from the parking lot to the shelter.

The nearest restroom facilities are located about 100 feet to the west. Each bathroom has a barrier free stall in addition to other facilities. There are cold water sinks available in each. The playground is nearby. There are also softball fields and horseshoe pits nearby.

Picnic Area A1 is located on the west end of the park. The area is partially shaded by a grove of cottonwood trees. There are 15 eight-foot tables in this section. A single, charcoal grill is available for your use. No electric service or water is available at the picnic area.

There is no paved path to the area but the terrain is grassy and level. The playground and restroom facilities are only a short walk from the picnic area.

### Rental Rules and Guidelines

- ◆ **Your reservation begins at 7am and ends at sunset.** This includes set-up and packing up time, please plan accordingly. We ask that the shelter be completely vacated promptly at the end of your rental period and that all trash be disposed of in the provided receptacles.
- ◆ If you plan on paying the fee for amusements/tents/pig roast etc. please call the Park Manager to discuss placement options and needs for your rentals. All rentals must be set up and removed the day of your reservation. They cannot be left overnight unless you have reserved the shelter again for the following day.
- ◆ Picnic tables must remain in the shelter.
- ◆ No amplified music is allowed in the park.
- ◆ Glitter, confetti, and water balloons are not allowed. Helium balloons may not be used inside the shelter.
- ◆ Golf carts and ATVs are not allowed to be used on park grounds.
- ◆ No fires or fireworks of any kind, including sky lanterns, are permitted on park grounds.
- ◆ The restrooms, playgrounds, and sports fields are not part of your reservation and are open to the public during park hours.

**Please understand that many groups reserve our park areas each season. These rules are in place to ensure that the park will be in good condition for your event and for events in the years to come. Thank you for choosing Creekside Park!**
