Picnic Area Information

Welcome to Palmer Park! We want your event to be a success, please let us know of any questions or concerns you have prior to arrival!

Palmer Park is located in the city of Wyoming. This 300 acre park is a shady retreat that is popular for group picnics and events. Paved and natural surface trails allow visitors to explore the park's forest and wetlands.

Open Shelter "A"

Open Shelter "A" is located at the south parking lot near the ball diamond. There are attached, barrier-free restroom facilities and a playground nearby. The shelter has 18 eight-foot picnic tables and seats up to 144 guests. A double grill, electrical service, and potable water are all available for your use.

Open Shelter "C"

Open Shelter "C" is located at the northern end of the park near the turn around. The nearest playground is over 200 feet away and the nearest restroom is over 100 yards away. The shelter has 18 eight-foot tables and can accommodate up to 144 guests. A double grill, electrical service, and potable water are available for your use.

Picnic Areas

Our Picnic Areas each have 14 eight-foot picnic tables and are suitable for groups of up to 112 people. There is a single, charcoal grill at each picnic section. There is no water or electrical service at the picnic areas. All of our picnic areas are shaded. The A area is closest to restrooms and the playground.

Picnic Rental Rules and Guidelines

- ◆ Do not remove tables from other sections to add to your area unless specific permission is given by park staff. If the tables in your section are not sufficient for your event, consider renting an additional area. This will also ensure sufficient parking for your group. Playground equipment, athletic fields, restrooms and parking areas cannot be reserved and will be open for public use.
- ◆ No vehicles are allowed in lawn areas, this includes delivery vehicles for chairs, tents, etc. Contact the park staff for delivery options to the Open Shelter. All vehicles must be parked in the parking lot.
- ◆ If you are planning on paying the fee for use of a commercial grill, pig roast or tent, please contact the Park Manager to discuss placement of these items.
- ◆ All decorations must be removed at the end of your rental, plan your event timing accordingly.
- ◆ Tents, chairs, etc. must be set up and taken down the day of your event.
- ◆ No artificial flower petals are allowed for outside events. No glitter is allowed for use in any area.
- ◆ Please be aware of placement of large items in lawn areas, don't leave anything large for long periods of time. No stages or dance floors are allowed in lawn areas.
- ◆ **All Open Shelter and Picnic areas must be cleaned up and out by sunset.** Check the sunrise/sunset calendar for Wyoming, MI to determine when your event must come to an end.

Please understand we have many groups that reserve our park areas each season. These rules are in place to ensure that the park will be good condition for your event, and for all future events.
