Release of Liability

1. The Renter will inspect the boating equipment and lease the same without any representations by Kent County Parks (Parks). The Renter agrees to return the boating equipment in the same condition as it was at the time of rental, and shall be responsible for any damages caused to the equipment.
2. Kent County Parks reserves the right to revoke the use of the boating equipment at any time for safety reasons.
3. The Renter acknowledges that the use and operation of the boating equipment is inherently risky, and agrees to expressly assume and accept all risks arising out of the boat rental activity.
4. The Renter will indemnify and hold harmless Parks and its agents, from any and all claims including claims of third party or minor children under his/her care, custody, and control, arising out of the boat rental activity.
5. The Renter expressly waives the right to institute any action against Parks and its agents, for any damage arising out of the boat rental activity.
6. The Renter agrees to follow Parks Ordinance, Rental Craft Rules and regulations.
7. The Renter has read and fully understood the above Release, and has voluntarily signed below.

Rental Craft Rules and Safety Information

- You will be responsible for paying late fees for any boats that are returned after the “due back” time(s) told to you by boat rental staff.
- No refunds will be provided due to inclement weather.
- Personal Flotation Devices (Lifejackets) must be worn by all passengers at all times.
- All passengers must remain seated in their rental craft at all times.
- Swimming from Rental Crafts is prohibited.
- Horseplay or other inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and will result in immediate suspension of privileges with no reimbursement.
- Children under 30 lbs. must have and use their own floatation device.
- Rental Craft must stay 20’ away from the designated swim area.
- No Alcoholic Beverages allowed on any rental craft.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Children between the age of 12 and 15 will be allowed to use rental without direct adult supervision, but a parent or guardian, is responsible for renting the craft and enforcing appropriate behavior.
- Do not exceed Maximum Capacities Ratings for persons and weights posted on the rental craft.

In an Emergency

- If the rental craft capsizes, STAY with vessel – it will still float when swamped with water.
- If possible, upright the swamped vessel, get in and paddle to where you can stand and dump the water.
